## ORDER CANCELING PRIVATE PAYPHONE CERTIFICATE

The Staff of the Commission (Staff) submitted a Memorandum to the Missouri Public Service Commission on February 17, 1998, asking the Commission to cancel Leon Timmons d/b/a L.T.'s Payphones' payphone certificate. The certificate had been granted by the Commission on May 18, 1995, in Case No. TA-95-307. The Staff advised the Commission that it had attempted to contact the certificate holder by telephone but had been unable to do so. Staff indicated Leon Timmons d/b/a L.T.'s Payphones had failed to file his 1996 Statement of Revenue and also that mail to the last address provided by Leon Timmons d/b/a L.T.'s Payphones was being returned as undeliverable. For these reasons, Staff felt that Leon Timmons d/b/a L.T.'s Payphones' payphone certificate should be canceled.

Section 392.410, RSMo Supp. 1997 gives the Commission authority over the granting of certificates of service authority to provide telecommunications services. The Commission has reviewed Staff's comments and finds that the private payphone certificate granted to Leon Timmons d/b/a L.T.'s Payphones in Case No. TA-95-307 shall be canceled.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the private payphone certificate granted to Leon Timmons d/b/a L.T.'s Payphones in Case No. TA-95-307 is canceled.
  - 2. That this order shall become effective on July 28, 1998.
  - 3. That this case may be closed on July 29, 1998.
