ORDER CONCERNING MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION

On June 28, 1990, United Telephone Company of Missouri (UTM) filed a motion herein for clarification. UTM states that the Commission's order directing that community optional service (COS) be implemented between the East Lynne exchange of Contel of Missouri, Inc., and UTM's Harrisonville exchange did not address whether two-way COS was to be provided by the billing adjustment method or the remote call forwarding (RCF) method. UTM notes that in an order issued April 18, 1990, in Case No. TO-90-232, the Commission stated that routes to be provisioned by RCF will be considered on a case-by-case basis until a comparison can be made of the relative merits of the two methods of providing two-way COS. The Commission has scheduled a hearing on September 25, 1990, to receive evidence on the relative merits of these two methods.

On July 9 and 17, 1990, Staff filed responses to UTM's motion. Staff states that until the local exchange companies demonstrate the economic feasibility of providing two-way COS by means of billing adjustments, Staff recommends that two-way COS between the East Lynne and Harrisonville exchanges be provided by means of RCF.

The Commission determines that Staff's recommendation concerning UTM's motion is reasonable and should be adopted. Therefore, the Commission will direct UTM to provision two-way COS on the East Lynne/Harrisonville route by means of the

RCF method, as long as the Commission has not adopted an alternative method of provisioning two-way COS.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the motion for clarification filed herein by United Telephone Company of Missouri be granted hereby as provided herein.
- 2. That United Telephone Company of Missouri be directed hereby to provision two-way community optional service (COS) on the East Lynne/Harrisonville route by means of the remote call forwarding (RCF) method provided that the Commission has not adopted an alternative method of provisioning two-way COS.
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof,
