ORDER DIRECTING IMPLEMENTATION AND APPROVING TARIFF SHEETS

On December 23, 1992, the Commission issued its Report and Order in Case No. TO-92-306 approving a statewide expanded calling scope plan. The plan, among other provisions, modifies community optional service (COS) to a two-way service only and adjusts the rates for COS. The Commission's Report and Order also directed its Technical Committee to file a report containing a schedule for implementation of the services established under the plan, including the modified COS. The Technical Committee filed its report on April 21, 1993.

The report contained a schedule for implementation of each proposed COS route which has passed the calling criteria to show a community of interest. The Commission is of the opinion that the report should be considered as Staff's recommendation that these routes be implemented, and based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission determines that the routes listed in Attachment A to this Order should be implemented by the primary toll carrier according to the schedule contained in the Technical Committee's report.

In anticipation of implementation, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (Bell) filed tariff sheets pursuant to the Commission's Report and Order in Case No. TO-92-306. The proposed tariff sheets are designed to implement the

additional COS routes listed in Attachment A to this Order, as well as the Fairdealing to Poplar Bluff route (Case No. TO-90-364). Bell has requested that the implementation date for the Fairdealing to Poplar Bluff route be changed from June 30, 1994 to August 31, 1993. The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum recommending that the Commission approve Bell's proposed tariff sheets for service on and after August 26, 1993.

Inasmuch as it expedites the implementation of the Commission's expanded calling scope plan, the Commission determines that the Fairdealing to Poplar Bluff route may be implemented on August 31, 1993 rather than June 30, 1994. Also, the Commission finds that Bell's proposed tariff sheets are in compliance with the Commission's Report and Order in Case No. TO-92-306. Thus, the Commission determines that the tariff sheets filed by Bell should be approved for service on and after August 26, 1993.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the community optional service routes listed in Attachment A to this Order shall be implemented by the primary toll carrier according to the schedule contained in the April 21, 1993 report of the Commission's Technical Committee.
- 2. That the community optional service route from Fairdealing to Poplar Bluff shall be implemented by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company on or before August 31, 1993.
- 3. That the following tariff sheets filed by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company are hereby approved for service on and after August 26, 1993: P.S.C. MO. No. 24
