ORDER DISMISSING APPLICATION

On February 17, 1995, Mark S. Wallace (Applicant) filed an application for a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service in Missouri. On February 28, 1995, the Commission issued an Order and Notice directing that applications to intervene be filed on or before March 31, 1995. No applications to intervene nor motions for hearing were filed.

On July 12, 1995, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum concerning the application. Staff states that Applicant had supplied incorrect information pertaining to his long distance operator service provider, and in attempting to determine Applicant's long distance operator service provider, numerous messages were left on Applicant's answering machine. Additionally, on April 20, 1995, Staff mailed a letter to Applicant requesting the missing information. Staff also states that all of its communications and requests have been ignored by Applicant. Staff recommends that the Commission dismiss Applicant's private pay telephone application.

Upon review of the application and Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that Applicant filed an incomplete and improper application, and that Applicant has failed to cooperate with Staff in

Staff's review of the application. Thus, the Commission determines that the application should be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the application filed by Mark S. Wallace is hereby dismissed.
 - 3. That this Order shall become effective on August 11, 1995.
