ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

On July 24, 1995, this complaint was initiated by David G. Jungerman (Complainant) against Kansas City Power and Light (KCPL), alleging improper billing to a business owned by the applicant. An answer to that complaint was filed by Kansas City Power and Light on August 31, 1995, denying the relevant portions of the allegations. On September 8, 1995, the Commission issued its order setting a procedural schedule in this matter.

On September 28, 1995, a joint motion was filed by Kansas City Power and Light and the complainant, stating that all issues in contention in this case have been resolved between the applicant and Kansas City Power and Light, and moving the Commission to dismiss this matter.

The Commission notes that the complainant has stated that this matter has been satisfactorily resolved and, therefore, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable. The motion to dismiss will be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the complaint, filed with the Commission on July 24, 1995, by David G. Jungerman, is hereby dismissed upon motion by the parties, all issues having been resolved between the parties.
 - 2. That the procedural schedule in this case is hereby cancelled.
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
