On October 25, 2018, GridLiance High Plains LLC, f/k/a South Central MCH LLC (“GridLiance”) asked the Commission to either find that it does not have jurisdiction over this project or, in the alternative, asked the Commission to grant GridLiance a certificate of convenience and necessity to build it.

The Commission finds that notice of the application should be given to the general public and interested parties and a date for intervention of proper parties should be set. The Commission’s Data Center shall mail a copy of this notice to the County Commission of Christian and Greene Counties. In addition, the Commission’s public information officer shall make notice of this order available to the media serving Christian and Greene Counties and to the members of the General Assembly representing Christian and Greene Counties.

The requirement of a hearing has been fulfilled when all those having a desire to be heard are offered an opportunity to be heard. If no proper party or governmental entity is granted intervention, and neither the Commission’s Staff nor the Office of the Public

Counsel requests a hearing, the Commission may determine that a hearing is not necessary for a determination on the application.¹

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Missouri Public Service Commission's Data Center is ordered to serve notice as described in the body of this order.

2. The Missouri Public Service Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department is ordered to serve notice as described in the body of this order.

3. Any proper person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application no later than November 13, 2018. Such applications shall be filed with:
