## RENEW MISSOURI'S SUGGESTED SPECIAL CONTEMPORARY ISSUES

COMES NOW, Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri ("Renew Missouri"), and pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-22.080(4), recommends the following special contemporary issues for consideration and analysis:

- 1. Analyze and document the current Effective Load Carrying Capacity ratings when evaluating forecasts for utility-scale solar facilities.
- 2. Analyze and document planning scenarios that include robust storage uptake consistent with FERC Order 841 including identifying current Battery Energy Storage System cost assumptions used to develop the scenario.
- 3. Analyze and document the reliability benefits associated with additional transmission investments identified.
- 4. Analyze and document the projected interconnection costs when evaluating additional supply side options.

WHEREFORE, Renew Missouri submits these special contemporary issues for the Commission's consideration.
