

**ORDER SETTING EVIDENTIARY HEARING**

On June 25, 2001, Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE (AmerenUE) filed an emergency motion requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission temporarily stay the expiration of the Second Experimental Alternative Regulation Plan (Second EARP). AmerenUE seeks expedited relief. The Commission will hold an evidentiary hearing on Thursday, June 28, 2001, beginning at 8:00 a.m., for the purpose of taking evidence and hearing argument on the issues presented in AmerenUE's motion, including whether the Commission can grant the relief sought by AmerenUE, and, if so, whether the Commission should grant it and under what conditions. Movant should be prepared to adduce evidence sufficient to support the action requested of the Commission and to demonstrate that good cause exists such that the public interest requires that the Commission act on expedited procedure.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That an evidentiary hearing shall be held on Thursday, June 28, 2001, beginning at 8:00 a.m. at the Missouri Public Service Commission's offices in the

Governor Office Building, Room 310, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. The Governor Office Building meets the accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. 2. That this order shall become effective on June 28, 2001.


