## ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

On July 14, 2022, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application with the Commission seeking an order granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) pursuant to Sections 393.140, 393.170.1 and 393.190.1, RSMo. The Commission directed notice and set a deadline of August 15, 2022, for applications to intervene. On August 12, 2022, Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri filed a timely application to intervene and on August 15, 2022, Sierra Club and Walmart, Inc. filed timely applications to Intervene.

More than ten days have passed since the applications were filed and no one has responded. After considering the unopposed applications to intervene, the Commission finds that Renew Missouri, Sierra Club, and Walmart have interests which are different from that of the general public and allowing them to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the applications to intervene.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The applications to intervene of Renew Missouri, Sierra Club, and Walmart are granted.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
