## ORDER TO FILE PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULES

The Missouri Public Service Commission is directing each party to file a proposed procedural schedule.

On November 20, 2009, the Commission convened a pre-hearing conference. At such conference, the parties began discussion of scheduling matters. The Commission directed the Commission's staff ("Staff") to file a report of whether the parties still desired the Commission to schedule a hearing at the conclusion of the conference. Staff's response reports that the parties desire a hearing scheduled to accommodate further discovery and the preparation and filing of pre-filed testimony. The Commission will make such accommodation, and determines that the best way to do so is by soliciting proposals from the parties.

Therefore, the Commission will direct each party to file a proposed procedural schedule.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than December 11, 2009, each party shall file a proposed procedural schedule.
2. Any party may file such schedule separately or jointly with any other party.

3. This order is effective immediately upon issuance.
