ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING DATES FOR SUBMISSION OF INTERVENTION REQUESTS AND STAFF RECOMMENDATION

On July 10, 2018, Timber Creek Sewer Company (“Timber Creek”) filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) requesting that the Commission grant it a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (“CCN”) to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage and maintain a sewer system in Clay County, Missouri. The requested CCN would allow Timber Creek to provide sewer service to an existing development known as Oak Ridge Subdivision. The Commission will direct that notice be given and set a deadline for intervention requests and Staff recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission’s Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to the County Commission of Clay County, Missouri and the Missouri Department of Natural Resources.
2. The Commission’s Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing Clay County, Missouri and to the media serving Clay County, Missouri.
3. No later than July 25, 2018, Timber Creek Sewer Company shall file suggestions on how to provide notice to the customers affected by the proposed transaction.

4. Any application to intervene shall be filed no later than August 1, 2018.
5. The Commission's Staff shall file a recommendation regarding Timber Creek Sewer Company's application no later than September 6, 2018.
6. This order shall become effective when issued.
