## ORDER MODIFYING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Issue Date: September 17, 2012

Effective Date: September 17, 2012

On September 13, 2012, the parties jointly proposed modifications to the procedural schedule. The Commission will adopt the procedural schedule as proposed with modifications.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The procedural schedule is modified as follows:

**Parties submit briefs on what tariff, statute, rule, order, or decision within the Commission's jurisdiction was violated and the legal standards to be applied** - **September 21, 2012**

**Cut-off for propounding data requests** - **October 5, 2012**

**Motion filing deadline, deposition deadline (all depositions completed)** - **October 12, 2012**

**Direct testimony by both parties** - **November 2, 2012**

**Rebuttal testimony by both parties** - **November 13, 2012**

<b>Prehearing briefs, issues list, order of witnesses and any time limits filed</b>	- <b>November 23, 2012</b>
<b>Joint Stipulation of Non-Disputed Material Facts</b>	- <b>November 26, 2012</b>
<b>Evidentiary Hearing</b>	- <b>November 29-30, 2012, beginning at 8:30 a.m.</b>
<b>Transcript</b>	- <b>December 17, 2012</b>
<b>Post-Hearing Briefs</b>	- <b>January 17, 2013</b>
<b>Proposed Findings of Fact and Proposed Conclusions of Law</b>	- <b>January 22, 2013</b>
<b>Reply Briefs</b>	- <b>January 29, 2013</b>

2. By agreement of the parties, discovery responses shall be expedited to five days for objections and ten days for responses.

3. Proposed findings of fact and proposed conclusions of law will include complete citations to the evidentiary record.

4. No other previously ordered procedural requirements are changed by this order.

5. The hearing shall be held at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, Room 310, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. 6. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
