4 Commission will decide how they want to go with it.

5 Anything that we need to discuss while we're
6 on the record?

7 MR. STEINER: I don't think so, Judge.

8 JUDGE MORRIS: Okay.

9 MR. OPITZ: No.

10 JUDGE MORRIS: Well, thank you very much
11 then. And, with that, we'll go off the record, and I'll
12 take my leave.
