**ORDER DIRECTING FILING**

On June 6, 2005, Timber Creek Sewer Company applied with the Commission requesting authority to construct, install, own, operate, control, manage, and maintain a sewer system in an unincorporated portion of Clay County, Missouri. The Commission issued its Order and Notice on June 8. In that order, the Commission ordered its Staff to file a Recommendation or a Status Report no later than July 8.

Staff filed a Status Report on July 8. In that report, Staff stated that it would file its Recommendation no later than August 29. Staff has failed to file its Recommendation or a pleading explaining its failure. The Commission will therefore order Staff to file a Recommendation.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the Staff of the Commission shall file its Recommendation no later than September 16, 2005.

2. That this order shall become effective on September 1, 2005.
