## ORDER CANCELLING HEARING

The Commission is canceling the hearing because no hearing is due. The

application ("application") of Timber Creek Sewer Company ("Timber Creek") seeks a

certificate of convenience and necessity. The application is subject to the following

procedure:

The commission shall have the power to grant the permission and approval herein specified whenever it shall after due hearing determine that such construction or such exercise of the right, privilege or franchise is necessary or convenient for the public service.<sup>1</sup>

Whether a hearing is "due" under that statute depends on whether the application faces

opposition.<sup>2</sup>

The only opposition to the application arose on September 9, 2009, when Platte County Regional Sewer District ("the District") filed the only motion for intervention. On October 5, 2009, the Commission granted that motion. But on April 8, 2010, the District withdrew its intervention. On April 14, 2010, the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC") filed a statement that OPC sought no hearing. Because the only opposition to the application is withdrawn, no hearing is due.

The statutory provision for a "due hearing"<sup>3</sup> means that the Commission may grant the unopposed application without a hearing,<sup>4</sup> so the Commission will cancel the hearing.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The hearing is canceled.
- 2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
