**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE  
TARIFF**

On November 12, 2015, the Commission granted Missouri-American Water Company a certificate of convenience and necessity to acquire and operate an existing sewer system in Benton County, Missouri. One provision in that order directed Missouri-American to submit a revised tariff incorporating the sewer system service area within 30 days of the December 12 effective date of the order. On January 7, 2016, Missouri-American filed a motion explaining that closing on the acquisition transaction has been delayed, and requesting that it be allowed until five days after closing occurs to submit the revised tariff. The Commission will grant the requested extension.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Missouri-American Water Company's Motion for Extension is granted.

2. Missouri-American Water Company shall submit a revised tariff to incorporate the new sewer system service area within five days after closing on the transaction occurs.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
