## ORDER CANCELING PRIVATE PAYPHONE CERTIFICATE

Jerome B. Goldenberg submitted a letter to the Missouri Public Service Commission on May 21, 1998, asking the Commission to cancel his payphone certificate. Jerome B. Goldenberg was granted the certificate on February 23, 1996, in Case No. TA-96-230. The Staff of the Commission advised the Commission that it had made contact with the certificate holder and that the certificate should be canceled because Jerome B. Goldenberg had never entered into the payphone business and had no plans to do so in the future.

Section 392.410, RSMo Supp. 1997 gives the Commission authority over the granting of certificates of service authority to provide telecommunications services. The Commission has reviewed Jerome B. Goldenberg's letter and Staff's comments and finds that the private payphone certificate granted to Jerome B. Goldenberg in Case No. TA-96-230 shall be canceled.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the private payphone certificate granted to Jerome B. Goldenberg in Case No. TA-96-230 is canceled.
  - 2. That this order shall become effective on July 23, 1998.

3. That this case may be closed on July 24, 1998.
