ORDER CANCELLING CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

By its order of March 31, 1992, the Commission authorized the sale of  
Union Electric Company's water system in Cape Girardeau to the City of Cape  
Girardeau. Ordered paragraph 2 of the Commission's order states:

"2. That Union Electric Company shall notify the Commission Staff not  
less than five days after said sale is final, at which time the Commission will  
cancel Union Electric Company's certificate of convenience and necessity and its  
then applicable tariffs and obligations to provide said water service."

On June 2, 1992, Union Electric Company formally advised the Commission  
and its Staff that the sale of its water system to the City had been consummated  
and that the City would take over operations of said system at 12:01 a.m., June  
3, 1992.

Pursuant to its order cited above, the Commission will herein cancel  
Union Electric Company's certificate of convenience and necessity as well as  
Company's present tariffs relating to said water system. On the effective date  
of this order, Company's statutory obligations to render service pursuant to  
Chapters 386 and 393, RSMo, will cease as to the Cape Girardeau water system.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That any and all certificates of public convenience and necessity issued to or held by Union Electric Company authorizing Company to own and operate a water system in Cape Girardeau, Missouri, and requiring Company to extend services thereunder, are hereby cancelled.

2. That any and all water tariffs now on file at the Missouri Public Service Commission which contain Union Electric Company's rates, charges and rules for rendering water service in Cape Girardeau, Missouri, including those tariffs given approval in Case No. EM-83-248, are hereby cancelled.

3. That this order shall be effective on the date hereof.
