ORDER CANCELLING CERTIFICATE AND TARIFF

On April 1, 1991, Compute-A-Call, Inc. (CACI), filed an application requesting cancellation of its certificate of service authority to provide intrastate telecommunications service in the State of Missouri. On March 13, 1990, in Case No. TM-90-193, the Commission issued an order approving the sale of 100 percent of CACI's stock to Communication, Inc., which holds its own certificate as a reseller of telecommunications services.

On September 16, 1991, the Commission's Staff (Staff) filed a memorandum in this case recommending that the Commission cancel CACI's certificate and tariff to expire on the same date since CACI no longer needs its certificate.

Based on CACI's application and the recommendation of Staff, the Commission determines that the certificate of service authority and tariff of CACI should be cancelled to expire on the same date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:
