# ORDER CANCELLING CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

On December 9, 1992, the BSN Research and Development Manager submitted a written request to cancel BSN's tariff and Certificate of Service Authority. BSN's letter indicates that as of September 1, 1992, BSN sold its customer base to Phoenix Network, Inc. and that for that reason BSN would no longer be providing non-facility based long distance resale in the state of Missouri. Accordingly, BSN requested permission to withdraw its tariff and to cancel its certificate.

Based upon a finding that the customer base has been sold and is now served by another reseller of intrastate interexchange telecommunications services and based upon the Staff recommendation, the Commission finds that it would not be detrimental to the public interest to grant BSN's request. The

Commission will, therefore, cancel BSN's Certificate of Service Authority and the accompanying tariff.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the Certificate of Service Authority which was granted on April 17, 1992 and the tariffs which subsequently became effective June 8, 1992 are hereby cancelled.

2. That this order shall become effective on January 15, 1993.
