

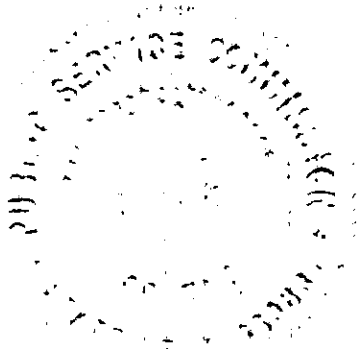
**ORDER DIRECTING FILING**
