ORDER DIRECTING STAFF RESPONSE

Osage Water Company (Osage), on October 12, 1999, filed a request for a rate increase pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.200. On August 8, 2000, Osage filed a motion to compel the Commission's Staff to complete its investigation into the amount of any rate increase justified for Osage. On October 4, 2000, Osage filed a second motion to compel the Staff to complete its investigation. In its second motion, Osage notes that Staff, on the record at a prehearing conference held September 14, 2000, stated that it had all the information that it needed to complete its investigation. Staff also stated on the record that it could "probably prepare a recommended stipulation within a couple of weeks." According to Osage, as of the date of Osage's second motion (three weeks after Staff's statement that it could have a recommendation within a couple of weeks, and very nearly a year since Osage first requested relief), Staff had not yet provided Osage with a recommendation as to rates. The Commission will direct Staff to file a pleading explaining why it is taking so long to prepare a recommended stipulation, and to advise the Commission of the date on which it will provide a recommended stipulation to Osage. Commission will also direct Staff to describe what additional information it received from Osage between August 23, 2000, when it stated that it



needed additional information and September 14, 2000, when it stated that it had all the information it needed. If no additional information was received, Staff will explain the basis for the statement in its August 23, 2000, pleading that it needed additional information.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Staff of the Commission shall file a pleading as described herein no later than October 6, 2000.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on October 5, 2000.
