ORDER DISMISSING PETITION

The Commission has received a petition signed by residents of the Jenkins exchange served by GTE Missouri requesting community optional service (COS) from the Jenkins exchange to the Aurora exchange served by GTE Systems.

The Commission recently approved a statewide expanded calling scope plan to provide customers with expanded calling. The plan implements a Metropolitan Calling Area (MCA) service in St. Louis, Kansas City and Springfield. The MCA service modifies and expands the Wide Area Service Plan currently in place in St. Louis and Kansas City. The plan also provides an Outstate Calling Area (OCA) service for those exchanges not included in an MCA. The OCA service is an optional service offered for expanded calling beyond a customer's local exchange within a 23-mile radius from each exchange's central office. The Plan also modifies COS to a two-way service only and adjusts the rates for COS.

Inasmuch as the expanded calling scope plan was not in place when the petition was submitted and COS has been changed from the service requested in the petition, the Commission is of the opinion that the residents of the Jenkins exchange should be given the opportunity to choose the type of service they wish to receive under the new calling scope plan. Thus, the Commission determines that the petition should be dismissed. A petition for the modified COS may be filed at any time.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the petition in this case is hereby dismissed.
