ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION

On April 27, 1990, GTE North Incorporated (GTE) filed a request for an extension of 90 days from May 1, 1990 to begin to provide two-way community optional service (COS) between its Centralia and Columbia exchanges. GTE states that it needs the extension to establish a new NXX in its Columbia exchange to handle the unexpectedly high volume of customers subscribing to COS in these exchanges.

The Commission has reviewed this matter and will grant the extension requested. The need for additional facilities is sufficient justification to warrant an extension for the implementation of COS.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That GTE North Incorporated is hereby granted an extension of ninety (90) days from May 1, 1990 to provide two-way community optional service between its Centralia and Columbia exchanges.

ORDERED: 2. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
