ORDER GRANTING WITHDRAWAL OF TARIFF SHEETS

On July 12, 1995, the Commission issued an order in which it granted a motion to strike a Joint Recommendation filed by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWB) and other local exchange companies (LECs) and the supporting testimony of Robert C. Schoonmaker. On July 18, 1995, SWB filed a pleading withdrawing its Local Plus tariff sheets which are under consideration in this case.

Following its decision concerning the Joint Recommendation, the Commission understood that SWB would in all likelihood withdraw the Local Plus tariff sheets. Since SWB has the burden of proof with regard to the reasonableness of its tariff sheets, it can withdraw those sheets at its own discretion. Since the tariffs sheets are withdrawn, the Commission will dismiss this case. As stated in its previous order, the Commission would encourage SWB and the other LECs to submit tariffs in conformance with the Joint Recommendation for consideration by the Commission.

Since the Commission is dismissing this case, all other motions are moot.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Commission hereby accepts Southwestern Bell Telephone Company's withdrawal of its Local Plus tariff sheets.
 - 2. That this case is dismissed.

3. That this order shall become effective on the 8th day of August, 1995.
