## ORDER GRANTING REVISED MOTION FOR APPROVAL OF CHANGES TO THE MISSOURI 271 AGREEMENT

Syllabus: The Commission grants Southwestern Bell Telephone Company's motion to make changes to the Missouri 271 Agreement to be consistent with the Report and Order in this case.

On July 11, 2002, Bell filed a motion for Commission approval of changes to the Missouri 271 Agreement (M2A) to make that agreement consistent with the Report and Order issued February 28. Several parties filed pleadings opposing Bell's proposed changes, and on August 2, Bell filed a revised motion.

In that revised motion, Bell stated that it had had discussions with the other parties, and had reached an agreement concerning the appropriate language for revisions to the M2A. The revised motion sets out that agreed-upon language. On August 9, the Staff of the Commission filed a response to the revised motion in which it stated that it had reviewed Bell's revised proposed modifications to the M2A and that the revisions comport with the Commission's order. No party responded to the revised motion or Staff's pleading.

The Commission finds that the changes proposed in Bell's revised motion are consistent with the Report and Order, and will grant the motion.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Revised Motion for Approval of Changes to the Missouri 271 Agreement filed on August 2, 2002, by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company is granted, and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company shall revise the Missouri 271 Agreement accordingly.
  - 2. That this order shall become effective on September 6, 2002.
