ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On March 23, 1994, AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. (AT&T) filed a proposed revision to its tariff. On March 28, 1994, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed its Memorandum in which it recommended approval of the tariff with an effective date of April 22, 1994. AT&T's proposed tariff has a proposed effective date of April 22, 1994, but AT&T has requested expedited approval of the tariff.

The proposed tariff would disallow calls billed to a third party from receiving the 25 percent discount. AT&T also proposes to add a specific rate schedule reflecting the 25 percent discount off the per minute rates, as well as the discounted operator service charges. Lastly, AT&T proposes to extend the promotion through April 30, 1994. The proposed revision would extend the 25 percent discount for its 1-800 CALL ATT Promotion through April 30, 1994.

The Commission has reviewed both the tariff as submitted by AT&T and also the Staff recommendation. The Commission finds AT&T's request for expedited approval should be granted for good cause shown. The Commission further finds the tariff is in the public interest and should be approved for service on and after April 22, 1994.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff sheets filed by AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc., on March 23, 1994, are hereby approved for service on and after April 22, 1994:
