ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On October 24, 1994, Stoutland Telephone Company (Stoutland) filed tariff sheets proposing to offer a second access line promotion in which the non-recurring installation charges would be waived for both existing and new residential customers subscribing to more than one access line at the same location. If approved, the promotion would run from November 15, 1994 through December 31, 1994. On November 9, 1994, Stoutland filed a substitute sheet correcting a page numbering error.

On November 9, 1994, the Telecommunications Department Staff (Staff) filed its Memorandum stating that it had examined the proposed tariff and had no objection to its approval on an expedited basis.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff, the Staff Memorandum filed herein and the entirety of the file and finds that Stoutland has requested expedited treatment for an effective date of November 15, 1994, in order for the authorized period of service to coincide with a planned promotion. The Commission finds that Stoutland has shown good cause for expedited treatment and the Commission will expedite this case. The Commission further finds that the planned promotional offering included in this tariff is just and reasonable and it is in the public interest for the Commission to approve the tariff.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff filed by Stoutland Telephone Company on October 24, 1994, is approved for service on and after November 15, 1994:
