ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEETS

On May 1, 1995, AT&T Communications of the Southwest Inc. (AT&T) filed proposed tariff sheets introducing a new promotional offering for operator services. On May 4, 1995, AT&T filed a substitute sheet to correct clerical errors. AT&T has requested expedited consideration of its proposal.

The promotion would provide discounted toll rates and service charges for customers who place operator station and person-to-person collect calls. The promotion would begin on the date the proposed tariff sheets become effective and would end on December 31, 1995.

On May 9, 1995, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum recommending that the Commission approve AT&T's proposed tariff sheets. Staff stated that it has no objections to the proposed tariff sheets or to their approval on an expedited basis. Staff also recommended that the tariff sheets be allowed to become effective as soon as ordered by the Commission.

Upon review of the proposed tariff sheets and Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that AT&T's proposal is reasonable. Thus, the Commission determines that the tariff sheets filed by AT&T on May 1, 1995, as substituted, should be approved for service on and after May 17, 1995.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following tariff sheets filed by AT&T Communications of the Southwest Inc. is hereby approved for service on and after May 17, 1995:

5th Revised Sheet No. 10 Canceling 4th Revised Sheet No. 10;
Original Sheet No. 10.1.

2. That this Order shall become effective on May 17, 1995.
