**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF**

On June 6, 1995, AT&T Communications of the Southwest Inc. (AT&T) submitted proposed tariff sheets along with a request for expedited service. AT&T has requested a July 1, 1995 effective date and this docket was created to address that request.

On June 22, 1995, the Telecommunications Department Staff of the Public Service Commission (Staff) filed its Memorandum in which it recommended approval of AT&T's tariff sheets. AT&T's proposal is to revise its "A" and "P" promotions for Software Defined Network (SDN) service and to introduce A and P promotions for Virtual Telecommunications Network Service (VTNS).

The Commission has reviewed the Staff Memorandum and the entirety of the file and finds that the A and P promotions for SDN were initially approved on October 12, 1994 and have subsequently been extended so that these promotions are now scheduled to expire on June 30, 1995. Both of these promotions offer subscribers promotional coupons or bill credits based upon the number of lines and services and the level of increased usage to which the subscriber commits. The conditions contained in AT&T's proposed tariff sheets are variations of the promotions now

offered by AT&T. For example, revised A promotion will offer customers Option 1 which is similar to the current A promotion and Option 2 which allows the customer to choose between the two-year maintenance agreement associated with their existing auto dialers, promotional coupons or bill credits. Lastly, the Commission finds the proposed promotions are comparable to and consistent with promotions offered by this and other telecommunications companies in the past and should be approved.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the tariff sheets filed herein on June 6, 1995, are approved for service on and after July 1, 1995:
