**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF**

On February 8, 1995, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued a Report and Order in which it approved the territorial agreement between Union Electric (UE) and Laclede Electric Cooperative, Inc. (Laclede). Pursuant to the Report and Order, UE filed a tariff sheet on March 3, 1995, with a proposed effective date of April 3, 1995. Ordered Paragraph No. 2 of the Report and Order directed, "That Union Electric Company shall file revised sheets within 30 days after the date of the order to comply with the territorial agreement authorized herein."

On March 10, 1995, the Energy Department Staff of the Public Service Commission (Staff) filed their memorandum in response to the tariff and in which they recommend approval of the tariff sheet.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheet which was filed, the Staff memorandum, and the file in its entirety and makes the following findings of fact. The Commission finds that pursuant to the territorial agreement UE is restricted from serving customers south of the boundary line to the Lake of the Ozarks, through Line Creek and which continues on an east west line through Camden County. The Commission finds that the tariff sheet filed herein is reflective of this territorial boundary restriction. The Commission finds that the tariff sheet is in compliance

with the Report and Order of February 8, 1995 and should be approved to become effective on and after April 3, 1995.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the tariff sheet filed by Union Electric Company shall be effective for service on and after April 3, 1995.
