ORDER APPROVING TARIFFS

On June 15, 1990, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWB) filed proposed tariff sheets to temporarily reestablish Extended Measured Service (EMS) discounts for the following selected routes: (1) Kansas City to Pleasant Hill; (2) Kansas City to Lone Jack; and (3) Bowling Green to Frankford.

SWB stated that United Telephone Company of Missouri was ordered by this Commission to continue its Extended Measured Service (EMS) discount for the Lone Jack and Pleasant Hill to Metropolitan Kansas City route. By implementing the 50% discount on directly dialed (1+) calls from the Kansas City Metropolitan area to the Lone Jack and Pleasant Hill exchanges, SWB would be reciprocating the discount. SWB proposed this discount be in effect until Community Optional Service (COS) is implemented. Bell also proposed the same 50% discount for calls placed from the Bowling Green to the Frankford exchange until two-way COS is implemented. The proposed tariff sheets contain a requested effective date of July 16, 1990, therefore, SWB requested expedited review.

On July 3, 1990, the Commission Staff (Staff) filed a memorandum recommending the tariff sheets be approved. The Commission has reviewed the sheets submitted and Staff's recommendation and has determined they should be approved to become effective on July 15, 1990.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


1. That the following tariff sheets filed by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company on June 15, 1990, be approved for service rendered on and after July 15, 1990.
