Michael Klopfenstein d/b/a Mega-Com Communications contacted the Internal Accounting Department of the Missouri Public Service Commission on March 19, 1997, asking the Commission to cancel his payphone certificate as he was no longer in the private payphone business. Michael Klopfenstein d/b/a Mega-Com Communications was granted the certificate on August 11, 1995, in Case No. TA-95-433. The Staff of the Commission advised the Commission that it had attempted to make contact with the certificate holder, was unable to do so, but still recommended that the certificate be canceled because Michael Klopfenstein d/b/a Mega-Com Communications was no longer operating a payphone business in Missouri.

Section 392.410, RSMo Supp. 1997 gives the Commission authority over the granting of certificates of service authority to provide telecommunications services. The Commission has reviewed Michael Klopfenstein d/b/a Mega-Com Communications' letter and Staff's comments and finds that the private payphone certificate granted to Michael Klopfenstein d/b/a Mega-Com Communications in Case No. TA-95-433 shall be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the private payphone certificate granted to Michael Klopfenstein d/b/a Mega-Com Communications in Case No. TA-95-433 is canceled.
2. That this order shall become effective on July 23, 1998.
3. That this case may be closed on July 24, 1998.
