ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

On October 23, 1991, the Commission's Staff (Staff) submitted a memorandum recommending that the above-referenced case be closed. Staff notes that it has reviewed the response of The Kansas Power & Light Company (KPL) to Staff's safety recommendations and that KPL has proposed various training programs and procedures which adequately address the problems which led to the gas incident which is the subject of this docket. Staff notes that it will continue monitoring KPL's activities as part of its ongoing pipeline safety inspection program.

In addition, Staff states that, as a result of the complaint filed by Staff as to this gas incident in Case No. GC-91-201, KPL has paid a settlement of \$6,000.00 and that the complaint case has been closed. Staff states no further formal action is contemplated in the above-referenced case.

Based upon the recommendation of its Staff, and the commitment of KPL to programs and procedures to prevent further such incidents from occurring, the Commission concludes that this docket should be closed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Case No. GS-91-7 be closed hereby.

2. That this order shall become effective on November 19, 1991.
