At a Session of the Public Service Commission held at its office in Jefferson City on the 26th day of April, 1995.

In the matter of the application of (Glens)

Adkins for certificate of service authority) CASE NO. TA-95-148 to provide private pay telephone service) within the State of Missouri.

ORDER DISMISSING APPLICATION

On October 31, 1994, Glen Adkins (Applicant) filed an application for a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service in Missouri. On November 3, 1994, the Commission issued an Order and Notice directing that applications to intervene be filed on or before December 2, 1994. No applications to intervene nor motions for hearing were filed.

On April 20, 1995, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum concerning the application. Staff states that when it contacted Applicant to ascertain his operator services provider, Applicant indicated he was no longer interested in providing pay telephone service and requested that his application be withdrawn. Staff also states that two requests by it for Applicant to submit his withdrawal in writing have been ignored. Staff recommends that the Commission dismiss Applicant's private pay telephone application.

Upon review of the application and Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that Applicant no longer intends to provide private pay telephone service in Missouri. Thus, the Commission determines that the application should be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the application filed by Glen Adkins is hereby dismissed.
 - 2. That this Order shall become effective on May 9, 1995.
