## ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

On August 8, 1993, a Complaint was filed by Robert Lee Allen alleging improper billing procedures for electric service by Missouri Public Service (MPS). Complainant alleged that he was being billed for another person's overdue bill who occasionally resided with the Complainant. Complainant alleged that MPS threatened termination of service if he failed to pay the alleged amount due.

On July 12, 1993, notice was sent to MPS regarding the nature of the Complaint and instructing MPS to respond or satisfy the Complaint within 30 days.

On August 12, 1993, MPS filed a letter with the Commission, signed by the Division Counsel for MPS, stating MPS would no longer attempt to collect the claim, in the amount of \$44.20, from the Complainant.

The Commission finds that the voluntary arrangement on the part of MPS is reasonable and satisfies the request of Complainant. The Complaint will be dismissed and MPS will be ordered to cease collection efforts for the \$44.20 in question against the Complainant.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Complaint filed by Robert Lee Allen against Missouri Public Service, as above described, is dismissed.
- 2. That Missouri Public Service, per its letter filed August 12, 1993, is ordered to cease its efforts to collect a past due bill in the amount of \$44.20, allegedly owed by Deborah Welch, from Complainant.
  - 3. That this order shall be effective August 31, 1993.
