ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

Curtiss R. Canady filed a complaint against WorldCom, Inc. d/b/a LDDS WorldCom (WorldCom) on December 11, 1995, regarding a billing dispute. The Commission issued a Notice of Complaint requiring WorldCom to respond to the complaint on or before January 12, 1996. On January 9, 1996, WorldCom filed a letter stating that the dispute had been settled. On January 16, 1996, Mr. Canady filed a memo stating that he was satisfied with the action taken to resolve the complaint.

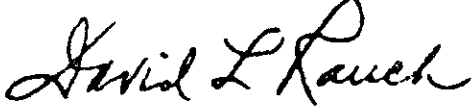
