On August 5, 2013, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCPL") submitted an application for Commission approval of its revised Net Metering Rider and Solar Photovoltaic Rebate program tariffs. KCPL states the revised tariffs incorporate recent legislative changes concerning the ownership of solar renewable energy credits and the timing of application submittals.

The Commission will order Staff to submit a recommendation and establish a time to apply to intervene or to object to the revised tariffs. Since this application may interest parties in File No. ET-2014-0026, notice shall be provided to them.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file a Recommendation no later than August 21, 2013 regarding Kansas City Power & Light Company's request for approval tariffs.

3. Any motion to intervene or asking the Commission to suspend or reject Kansas City Power & Light Company's revised Tariff Sheets No. 34 through 34I, 34L, 34N, 34P through 34S Net Metering Interconnection Agreement and Tariff Sheets No. 46A and 46N Solar Photovoltaic Rebate Program tariffs must be filed no later than August 21, 2013.

4. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
