ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

On May 24, 2000, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE and Intercounty Electric Cooperative Association filed a joint application requesting that the Commission approve a territorial agreement between the two applicants. On May 26, the Commission issued an Order and Notice that directed all interested parties to file an application to intervene no later than June 15. On June 9, the City of Rolla, by and through Rolla Municipal Utilities (Rolla), filed an Application to Intervene.

The Commission has reviewed the Application to Intervene and finds that it is in compliance with Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.075. Rolla has an interest in this matter that is different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by the final order arising from this case. Furthermore, granting the proposed intervention would serve the public interest. The Commission concludes that the Application for Intervention filed by Rolla should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Application to Intervene filed by the City of Rolla, by and through Rolla Municipal Utilities, is granted.
2. That this order shall become effective on June 30, 2000.


