ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DISMISS

On September 11, 1989, the Union Electric Company (UE) applied for a waiver of tariff charges for a store and residence near Dexter, Missouri. The application was made to meet unregulated competition by a rural electric cooperative.

On May 9, 1990, UE moved to dismiss their application, stating that the cooperative began serving the store and residence shortly after UE made their application for waiver.
