On July 18, 2005, SPB Holdings, LLC, d/b/a State Park Village Wastewater Treatment System, applied for a certificate of convenience and necessity. On February 22, 2006, State Park Village filed a Motion to Dismiss Without Prejudice in which it stated that the principal of State Park Village has died, and that State Park Village's assets are being sold to another entity that may file a new application.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) states that a party may dismiss an application without an order of the Commission before prepared testimony or oral evidence has been offered. The parties have not offered prepared testimony or oral evidence. The Commission, therefore, will take notice of State Park Village's dismissal. This case may be closed.
