## ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the Application to Intervene of Platte County Sewer District ("motion").

Timber Creek Sewer Company ("Timber Creek") filed the application that is the subject of this action on August 21, 2009. On September 21, 2009, Platte County Sewer District (the "District") filed the motion. Any response to the motion was due ten days after filling, but the Commission received no response to the motion.

In the motion, the District alleges that it:

- (A) . . . has an interest which is different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case; or
- (B) Granting the proposed intervention would serve the public interest.<sup>2</sup>

The District meets that standard because it alleges that it already has a certificate of necessity and convenience to provide services in part of the area that is the subject of Timber Creek's application.

Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion.
