#### ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On March 24, 2011<sup>1</sup>, Lake Region Water & Sewer Company (hereafter "Lake Region") filed tariff sheets, effective April 23, to allow it to provide sewer service in Camden County, Missouri. Lake Region filed the tariff as ordered by the Commission on March 9, in the Commission's Order Granting Certificate of Convenience and Necessity.

The Commission's Staff filed its Recommendation on April 6, stating that Staff recommended that the Commission approve the submitted tariff filing.

The Commission has authority to approve tariff sheets pursuant to Sections 393.140(11) and 393.150, RSMo. Also, Section 393.130.1, RSMo, requires that charges for sewer service be just and reasonable. The Commission's order granting the certificate also approved the rates for the new service territory. This means that the Commission has already found the rates to be charged to be just and reasonable.
