**ORDER DIRECTING FILING**

On September 7, 2017, Missouri-American Water Company (“MAWC”) filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) requesting that the Commission grant it a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (“CCN”) to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage and maintain a sewer system in St. Louis County, Missouri. The requested CCN would allow MAWC to provide water service to an existing development known as Radcliffe Place. The Commission granted that application on December 6, 2017.

On December 28, 2017, MAWC filed the above-denominated tariff to comply with the Commission’s December 6, 2017 order. That tariff bears an effective date of January 27, 2018.

MAWC also filed a Motion for Expedited Treatment with its tariff. In the motion, MAWC asks for the tariff to become effective on January 8, 2018. MAWC explains that the transaction allowing it to buy Radcliffe Place will become effective on January 8, 2018. Thus, a tariff effective date of January 8, 2018 will reduce or eliminate any gap between the

Radcliffe Place purchase and the effective date of the tariffs under which MAWC would serve Radcliffe Place customers.

The Commission will order its Staff to file a Recommendation.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission's Staff shall file a recommendation regarding Missouri-American Water Company's tariff and Motion for Expedited Treatment no later than January 3, 2018.
2. Any other party who wishes to respond to Missouri-American Water Company's tariff and Motion for Expedited Treatment shall do so no later than January 3, 2018.
3. This order shall be effective when issued.
