## ORDER CANCELING SEWER TARIFF SHEETS AND SEWER CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

On April 11, 1995, Riverside Utility Company (Riverside) filed an application for authorization from the Commission to sell a sewer system used by customers located in the Short Creek Improvement District. The Short Creek Improvement district is located in Taney County, Missouri. Riverside proposes to sell the sewer system to the Taney County Regional Sewer District (District).

In the application Riverside requested that the Commission issue an order canceling the tariff filed by Riverside for this area and canceling the certificate of public convenience and necessity for sewer service issued to Riverside in Case No. WA-81-255.

On November 15, 1995, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum to the official case file. Staff recommended that the Commission issue an order canceling Riverside's sewer tariff and sewer certificate of convenience and necessity after receiving notice that the closing had occurred.

On November 28, 1995, the Commission issued an order which approved Riverside's application to sell the sewer system. The order also directed Riverside to notify the Commission of the sale after it had occurred.

On December 27, 1995, Riverside filed a letter in this docket, which letter states that the sale was closed on December 18, 1995. The Commission will order that the sewer tariff of Riverside Utility Company be canceled. The Commission will further order that the certificate of public convenience and necessity for sewer service issued to Riverside Utility Company in Case No. WA-81-255 be canceled.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the sewer tariff of Riverside Utility Company be, and is hereby, canceled.
- 2. That the certificate of public convenience and necessity issued to Riverside Utility Company in Case No. WA-81-255 to provide sewer service be, and is hereby, canceled.
  - 3. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
