ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION FOR
PERMISSION TO FILE PLEADING OUT OF TIME

On August 15, 2002, Complainant filed a Motion for Permission to file Pleading Out of Time. On July 30, 2002, the Commission ordered Complainant to file a pleading by August 13, 2002. Complainant did not learn of that order until August 13, 2002.


Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.050(3)(B) allows the Commission to permit an ordered act to be done after the expiration of the specified period if the failure to act was the result of excusable neglect. The Commission finds Complainant's failure to timely file his pleading was the result of excusable neglect.

Complainant is directed to file his pleading with the Commission by August 19, 2002 and to serve a copy upon Respondent as directed below. In its response, Complainant will clearly state whether or not it consents to participate in voluntary mediation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Manager of the Manufactured Housing and Modular Units Program of the Missouri Public Service Commission must file its response to this Notice and Order upon the Commission and Respondent **no later than August 19, 2002**. Complainant must clearly state whether it consents to participate in voluntary mediation.
2. That the deadlines in this case, including the period within which a responsive pleading must be filed, are tolled until further order of this Commission.
3. That this order will be effective on August 15, 2002.
