ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO EXTEND EFFECTIVE DATE OF REPORT AND ORDER

On December 14, 2000, the Commission issued a Report and Order with an effective date of Sunday, December 24, 2000. On December 15, 2000, UtiliCorp United Inc. filed a motion asking that the Commission extend the effective date of the Report and Order until Wednesday, December 27, 2000. UtiliCorp's motion indicates that because the current effective date falls on a Sunday it effectively has only eight days to analyze the Commission's decision and to prepare written exceptions.

The Commission has considered UtiliCorp's motion and finds that it should be granted.
