ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By order issued herein on November 2, 1990, the Commission adopted a Staff recommendation and granted Arkansas Power & Light Company (APL) temporary waiver of the filing of a decommissioning cost study for its Arkansas Nuclear One generating station as required by 4 CSR 240-20.070 (9). The recommendation was based on the pendency of Case No. EM-91-29 in which APL has sought approval of the sale of substantially all of its Missouri properties to Union Electric Company.

By Report and Order issued and effective October 4, 1991, in Case No. EM-91-29, APL was granted authority to transfer its Missouri properties to Joint Applicant Union Electric and to cease doing business in the State of Missouri as a public utility subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

Since no Missouri ratepayer has any further exposure to the payment, in electric rates, of any portion of the decommissioning cost of Arkansas Nuclear One as a result of the transfer approved, the Commission is of the opinion that further consideration of the waiver herein involved is unnecessary. The application should be dismissed without further proceedings.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the application of Arkansas Power & Light Company for a waiver of any requirements to file tariffs reflecting increased decommissioning funding pending herein be dismissed and no further proceedings be held.

2. That this Order shall become effective on October 4, 1991.
