ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF

On August 14, 2001, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a motion asking the Commission to suspend a proposed tariff issued by Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE on July 30, 2001. The tariff carries an effective date of August 29, 2001. Public Counsel's motion argues that it needs more time to evaluate AmerenUE's tariff and requests that the tariff be suspended.

On August 20, the Commission issued an order shortening the time for the filing of a response to Public Counsel's motion. The Commission directed that any party wishing to respond to Public Counsel's motion do so on or before August 22. The Staff of the Commission filed a response on August 22. Staff's response recommends that AmerenUE's tariff be suspended for 30 days to permit the parties to negotiate and come to an agreement regarding the revised tariff provisions. Staff indicates that AmerenUE and Public Counsel agree that the tariff should be suspended for 30 days.

Given the agreement of the parties, the Commission will suspend the tariff for 30 days.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


1. That the Office of the Public Counsel's Motion to Suspend is granted.
2. That the proposed tariff sheets issued on July 30, 2001, by Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE, and assigned Tariff No. 200200068, are suspended for a period of 30 days beyond August 29, 2001 to September 28, 2001, or until otherwise ordered by this Commission. The tariff sheets suspended are:

3. That this order shall become effective on August 29, 2001.
