PRO-RATA ADJUSTMENT OF MONTHLY MINIMUM CHARGE – If the customer is forced to close operations of its works for a period of 10 days or more on account of accidents, fires, damage to works, strikes of its own employees, act of God, Governmental regulations or other physical cause not reasonably within its control, and customer gives Water Company written notice not later than forty days after such occurrence the customer will be entitled to pro rata reduction in the monthly minimum charge which is based on 60% of the maximum usage during the previous months of June, July, August, or September for the period during which the customer is unable to use full water service for such cause.

DURATION OF CLASSIFICATION – Customers electing Tariff Rate J are required to remain in this classification for a period of at least twelve (12) months.

A Rate J customer whose usage is less than 60,000 cubic feet per month more than two times during a twelve (12) month period will no longer meet the eligibility requirements of this classification.

Customers who no longer meet the eligibility requirements of this classification, or elect to leave this classification, will be reclassified to Tariff Rate A, and must remain in the Rate A classification for a minimum of twelve (12) months and meet the monthly minimum usage requirements again before being classified under the Tariff Rate J.

Bill Consolidation Tariff

DESCRIPTION AND TERMS:

To provide for the consolidation of water usage for billing purposes for customers in all districts owning and occupying contiguous properties served by multiple meters. Qualifying customers and facilities are those locations where a customer's property or contiguous properties are served by a single distribution main or distribution facility, although service is provided through more than one meter.

APPLICABILITY:

This consolidation will be provided to existing customers who apply and whose eligibility under the terms above is confirmed by the Company. Initiation of the bill consolidation for an existing customer will commence at the conclusion of the Company's next general rate case, except for The Boeing Company and Daimler Chrysler, for whom the experiment will start as soon as possible after the effective date of this tariff sheet. New customers may apply for such consolidation at the time service is requested. Bill consolidation will be applied for new customers to the first bill issued to the customer following application and the Company's confirmation of eligibility.

RATE CALCULATION

Customers qualifying for bill consolidation will be charged for each meter associated with each of the subject property or contiguous properties. Consumption rates under Rate J will be applied to the total aggregated usage of all meters at the property or contiguous properties to arrive at the total bill for service. For Rate J, the 60% maximum usage criteria for any of the months of June, July, August, or September will be based on the consolidated consumption volume. Thus, the customer's bill calculation will be governed by the rules for the Rate J tariff until such time the customer is no longer eligible under the Experimental Bill Consolidation Tariff.

BILLING OF EVERY LICENSE, OCCUPATION, GROSS RECEIPTS, OR OTHER SIMILAR TAX, CHARGE, FEE, EXACTION OR PAYMENT

APPLICABILITY - This schedule is applicable to all water and service sold by the Company under every rate filed with the Public Service Commission of the State of Missouri.

There shall be added to each customer's bill, whether a retail or wholesale customer, as a separate item, an amount equal to every tax, charge, fee, exaction, or payment, now or hereafter imposed upon the Company by any political subdivision of the State of Missouri, whether by ordinance franchise, or otherwise, for the license, privilege or right to do business in such political subdivision (hereinafter called "license tax"), applicable to water and service sold by the Company to each customer.

In the event that such license tax is imposed as a percentage of receipts or revenues received by the Company in a political subdivision, the rate imposed by such political subdivision shall be applied against the receipts or revenues, including license tax, received from each customer located within such political subdivision in determining the amount of license tax to be added to each customer's bill.

In the event that a political subdivision imposes a license tax in the form of a flat sum rather than as a percentage of Company's receipts or revenues within such political subdivision, the Company's receipts or revenues in such political subdivision for the year preceding the year of payment of such flat sum shall be used for the purpose of computing the percentage of which the aggregate amount of all such license taxes paid to such political subdivision is of the receipts or revenues obtained by the Company within such political subdivision. The percentage so obtained shall be applied against the receipts or revenues, including license tax, received from each customer located within such political subdivision in determining the amount of license tax to be added to each customer's bill.

Where more than one such license tax is imposed by a political subdivision, the total of such license taxes applicable to a customer shall be billed the customer as a single amount.
